Update on Verges

We are working closely with Verging on Wild on the protection of the fauna and flora on identified RVNR sites but as the grass and flora grows, where a safety concern becomes apparent regarding road users this will take priority. If a member of the public reports a safety concern a LS will be sent out to investigate and assess the site. If it is found the safety of road users is impeded the steward will raise a job to have an area of the verge cleared to ensure a clear visual splay for road user safety. Every effort will be made to ensure as much of the wild verge is left untouched as practically possible.
