Children's and Families (C&F): There is significant change taking place within the Directorate from the recent judgement from Mr Justice Keehan including the employment of an Interim Director and additional Assistant Director to focus on safeguarding practice. The findings revealed in the judgement have been shocking and upsetting for all concerned. Details of the judgement can be found via the Council's website (Full Council Extraordinary meeting held on the 27th April).

Councillors need to be physically present in meetings as from the 7th May: parish councillors and Herefordshire Councillors in England are to be physically present in meetings in order to vote. This ruling is not equal across all elected members as it excludes MPs. A significant number of Herefordshire Councillors have raised their concerns with MPs (incl. central government advisers) and the Local Government Association that this ruling contravenes current Coronavirus Restrictions (which have been put in place to protect public health) and the Equality Act 2010. Herefordshire Council is asking for legislation that allows for hybrid meetings.
